



Photographer's Release Form

Any images created on any Great River Film Initiative movie set, event or meeting should be taken only on the consent of the group's president or the movie's producer.

Photographers agree to supply to the appropriate leadership members high-resolution images for the group's use after each photo shoot.

Copyright use is extended to the group for unlimited use to promote the group, as the leadership approves, at no charge to the group unless arrangements are made prior to the photo shoot. This may include movie marketing materials, website and other uses not listed that are authorized by GRIFIN.

Although this unlimited use is given to the Great River Film Initiative, ownership of the image copyright is retained by the photographer.

The following is a non-comprehensive example of how the granted rights might be used.

Once an image is selected to be used as primary art for a movie's marketing campaign, the image is then used on a movie poster, a DVD cover and insert, in a newspaper advertisement and is sent out with press releases as promotional stills. The movies' poster is included in an encyclopedia of movie posters (once the group authorized its use)-this is all controlled by Great River Film Initiative.

The photographer may print, sell or license the use of the original images as long as that sale/license would not negate the tenants of this agreement.
